EXERCISE #2

Chief Complaint: Contraceptive Placement of IUD |1|

Indication: Patient is a 24 year old, gravida 2, para 2 who is status post a normal spontaneous delivery 9 weeks ago. She has not had intercourse since delivery. She is interested in a Mirena IUD ^[2] at this time.

Procedure: After obtaining consent, the patient is placed in the dorsal lithotomy position. A speculum was placed in the vagina to visualize the cervix. The cervix was cleaned 3 times with Betadine. Following this, a single tooth tenaculum was placed on the anterior lip of the cervix. The uterus was sounded to approximately 6.5 cm. The Mirena IUD was then placed in the usual fashion and the strings cut to 2.5 cm [3]. The lot number is TU003SP. The patient tolerated the procedure well, and hemostasis was noted at the tenaculum site after removal.

The patient tolerated the procedure well and instructions were given to return if she has any problems.

What are the CPT° and ICD-10-CM codes reported?

CPT*: 58300

ICD-10-CM: Z30.430

Rationale:

CPT*: The patient presented for IUD placement as a means of contraception. In the CPT* Index locate Insertion/Intrauterine Device (IUD) and you're directed to 58300. A review of the code description confirms this is the correct code for the insertion of an IUD.

ICD-10-CM: In the ICD-10-CM Alphabetic Index locate Intrauterine contraceptive device/insertion and you're directed to Z30.430. The Tabular List confirms this is the correct code for an encounter for insertion of intrauterine contraceptive device.
