PREOPERATIVE DIAGNOSIS: Pericardial effusion

POSTOPERATIVE DIAGNOSIS: Pericardial effusion

COMPLICATIONS: None

CONDITION: Stable

OPERATIVE FINDINGS: Large purulent pericardial effusion ^[1], sent for Gram stain, culture, and cytology

PROCEDURE: With the patient under general anesthesia and endotracheal intubation, after a radial arterial line was placed, the patient was positioned and prepped and draped in a sterile manner. A subxiphoid incision was made with dissection to the linea alba, which was incised ^[2]. The pericardium was grasped and incised ^[3], and upon incision of the pericardium, purulence emanated from the pericardial sac under pressure. This was evacuated ^[4] and sent for Gram stain and culture. A window of pericardium was excised and a portion sent for culture and permanent section. ^[5] Additional cytology was sent from the remaining pericardial effluent. A chest tube was placed, the incision closed in layers. ^[6] The patient tolerated the procedure well. All counts were correct.

Diagnosis indicates pericardial effusion.

^[2] A subxiphoid incision was made with dissection to the linea alba, which was incised.

^[3] The pericardium was grasped and incised.

^[4] Upon incision of the pericardium, purulence emanated from the pericardial sac under pressure, which was evacuated.

^[5] A window of pericardium was excised and a portion sent for culture and permanent section.

⁶ A chest tube was placed, the incision closed in layers.

What are the CPT[®] and ICD-10-CM codes reported?

CPT[®] Code: 33025

ICD-10-CM Code: I31.39

Rationales:

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CPT[®]: The pericardial window procedure was performed to resolve pericardial effusion.

Based on our identified key elements a code selection will be made from the Pericardium category of CPT*. The note documents a pericardial window procedure. The CPT* Index look for Pericardial Window/Creation/for drainage 32659, 33025. Due to the operative note not specifying the procedure as a surgical thoracoscopy (Video-assisted thoracic surgery [VATS]), the appropriate code selection is 33025 *Creation of pericardial window or partial resection for drainage*.

ICD-10-CM: The postoperative diagnosis documents pericardial effusion. In the ICD-10-CM Alphabetic Index look for Effusion/ pericardium, pericardial referring you to I31.39. Verify in the Tabular List.

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
