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## Documentation Dissection

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**HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS:** This is a 73-year-old male with a history of metastatic prostate cancer to bone. He has been on chemotherapy, received a dose of chemotherapy this past Wednesday. He is here today for follow up of his cancer.

**IMPRESSION:**

1. Prostatic cancer <sup>[1]</sup> with bone mets <sup>[2]</sup>.

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<sup>[1]</sup> Primary cancer is prostate cancer.

<sup>[2]</sup> Secondary cancer is bone cancer.

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What ICD-10-CM code(s) is/are reported?

**ICD-10-CM Codes:** C61, C79.51

**Rationale:** The patient has primary prostate cancer with secondary bone cancer. Look in the ICD-10-CM Table of Neoplasms for prostate and use the code from the Malignant Primary column C61. Next, look in the ICD-10-CM Table of Neoplasms for bone and use the code from the Malignant Secondary column C79.51. Verify both codes in the Tabular List.

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
